Explanation/Intention of the proposal/reason for the proposal:

Introduction of a new 5gait-test

Exact Wording of proposal:

Co-existence of two equivalent 5gait-tests.

Five-gait O = five-gait with pace on the oval track

Five-gait P = five-gait with pace on the (next to the oval track) pace track

The organizer, no matter which one, also of a World Championship, decides which test will be advertise.

Consequences / implications for other R&R:

S2.8.18 F1X – Five-gait Test

The pace in this test is performed on a pace track with a minimum length of 200 m. The pace track will have the follow markings: A zone of 30 meters for transition to pace, a zone of 80 meters for showing pace and a zone of 30 for slowing down. Other gaits are performed on an oval track.

S2.8.18.1 Eligible horses

Combinations starting in this class are excluded from other four- and five-gait tests at the same event.

S2.8.18.2 Preliminary Round

Riders compete individually. The sections performed on the oval track can be ridden on either rein. The rider has three and a half rounds at his disposal to show the following gaits in any order:

1. slow to medium speed tölt
2. slow to medium speed trot
3. medium walk
4. slow to medium speed canter

Each of those gaits may be shown only once, walk for a half round and the other gaits for one round.

5. pace

The pace is shown on a pace track and in the direction as the track has been marked. The pace may be shown once.

The marks for tölt and pace will be doubled.

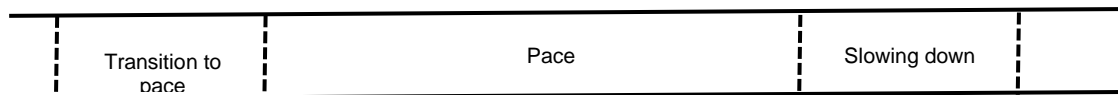
S2.8.18.3 Final Round

The finalists show the required sections as instructed by the speaker as described in S2.3.2. The order will be as follows:

1. slow to medium speed tölt
2. slow to medium speed trot
3. medium walk
4. slow to medium speed canter
5. pace

The pace is ridden on a pace track and is shown twice.

The marks for tölt and pace will be doubled.
